student tuition charges in FY 2022 by \$5 per credit hour.

For a student taking 15 credit hours a semester, the tuition cost will be \$2,574.30. For 30 credit hours		
(two semesters), the cost will be \$5,148.60.

Impact on Budget:		Tuition is a major part of the operating budget. The increase
		will improve the longer term fiscal integrity of the college.
