



Unusual Circumstances (Dependency) Appeal Form

FCXXADEP

The basic premise of federal financial aid is that students and parents have the primary obligation to finance post-secondary education to the extent that they are able. This form is to be used by those financial aid applicants who are seeking a review of their dependency status based upon circumstances not addressed in current federal dependency definitions.

[Note: if you have the official documentation for any of the following please turn it into the Office of Financial Aid and do not complete this form: Legal guardianship, Official homelessness liaison documention, Ward of the court, or Emancipation]

REQU	RED STEPS	
1.	Collect documentation. Submit appropriate third-party documentation from a professional (counselor, physician, lawy clergy, etc.) which verifies your estrangment from your parents or your parents' unavailability to help you in this applicances. NOTE: Appeals submitted without appropriate third-party documentation will not be reviewed.	
	Depending on your situation, below are examples of documentation we would need to review:	
	- Homelessness – you would need to submit three signed and dated statements about the situation from 1.) yourself; someone who knows about the situation; and 3.) a professional third-party (like a pastor, high school guidance coupolice report, etc.).	•
	- Mental/Physical Incapacitation – you will need to submit any official documentation showing your parent(s) are no mentally or physically capable of assisting with finances for you; and a signed and dated statement from you of t situation.	
	- Incarceration – you will need to submit your signed (and dated) statement about your situation; and submit the course or official federal or state documentation that your parents or legal guardians are incarcerated.	rt orde
	- Other – you will need to submit your signed (and dated) statement about your situation, and submit third party documentation based on your situation.	
2.	Submit all required documentation. Submit third-party documentation to the Office of Financial Aid as soon as possible receipt of your letter of ineligibility.	le afte
