## TYPES OF CAREER-TECH CREDIT

- CAREER-TECHNICAL AGREEMENTS (ARTICULATED CREDIT) These are agreements set up between Edison State Community College and high school career-tech programs. These agreements are a seamless pathway to college that avoids duplication of content. An Application for College Credit must be completed by the career-tech Instructor, signed by the student, and submitted to Edison State by May 1st.
- CAREER-TECHNICAL ASSURANCE GUIDE (CTAG) CTAGs are statewide agreements offered
  in commonly taught career-tech courses. College credit is earned by students who demonstrate
  proficiency in specific career-tech courses. Credits are documented through a statewide
  verification process (CTAV) and are posted mid-summer after high school graduation.

## **EARNING CAREER-TECH CREDIT**

Each career-tech program and course has unique requirements to earn credit such as end of course assessments (WebXams), grades, and credential requirements. Career-tech credits go through a verification process and credits are typically posted mid-summer following high school graduation.
