

2017-2018 Pell Lock-in Policy  
Effective Summer 2017



Pell awards will be recalculated twice in a semester.

**For summer 2017**, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 6/20/2017. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 7/11/2017.

Students who increase their credits between 6/20 and 7/11 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 6/20 and 7/11 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

**For fall 2017**, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 9/12/2017. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 11/07/2017.

Students who increase their credits between 9/12 and 11/07 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 9/12 and 11/07 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

**For spring 2018**, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 1/31/2018. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 4/03/2018.

Students who increase their credits between 1/31 and 4/03 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 1/31 and 4/03 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.
