

Computer User Agreement

This agreement applies to all users of Edison Community College computing resources, whether affiliated with the College or not, and whether the user accesses resources from on campus or remote locations, or via college-owned or personally-owned technological devices.

The following are strictly prohibited:

- Abusing, damaging, destroying, or interfering with computer equipment, software, or systems.
- Installing or using unauthorized hardware or software.
- Sharing username, password, or other personal account information with another.
- Violating or supporting and encouraging the violation of local, state, federal, or international law.
- Downloading, duplicating, disseminating, printing, or otherwise using materials such as software, texts, music, and graphics in violation of copyright laws.
- Operating a business, directly or indirectly, for personal gain.
- Organizing, wagering on, or participating in any type of gambling activity.
- Downloading, displaying, transmitting, duplicating, storing, linking to, or printing material that may be perceived as offensively violent, obscene, threatening, or harassing to a reasonable person.
- Sending or forwarding emails, texts, voice mail, or other electronic communications that
 - Contain libelous, defamatory, offensive, obscene, or racist remarks
 - Are intended to harass, intimidate, or otherwise annoy another person
 - Are unsolicited messages or 'chain mail'
 - Forge or attempt to forge by disguising or attempt to disguise identity, or
 - Promote events not officially sanctioned or sponsored by Edison
 - Solicit for money or support on behalf of individuals, charities, religious entities, or political causes.

As a public institution in the state of Ohio, Edison is subject to an Open Document Policy under the proper authority and restrictions. Email or other electronic communications may be seen by others if requested under the Ohio Public Records Acts (ORC 149.39).

The College accepts no responsibility for any damage to or loss of data, or compromising of user accounts arising directly from or incidental to the use of computing, communication, or information system resources.

I have read this agreement, I understand that any violation may result in disciplinary action, and I implicitly acknowledge, by continued system use, my agreement to comply.
