#### Homework

I will give a grade of 0 until the new picture is received, then I will regrade it for full credit.
- Homework assignments should not be submitted to the instructor's email without prior arrangements.
- Handwritten assignments **MUST** have supporting work (calculations or explanations) to receive points. Partial credit may be given for correct work with an incorrect answer.
- No late work is accepted. Due date extensions may be granted for extenuating circumstances.
- There will be one lab experiment and a formal lab report. The rubric and instructions for the lab will be given on Blackboard after the third exam.

## Exams

- There will be 3 exams throughout the course and a final exam at the end. The exam weeks are posted on the tentative weekly schedule.
- Exams are taken on Blackboard using LockDown browser and a webcam. Follow instructions on Blackboard to install the LockDown browser software.
- Supporting work for each exam may be submitted for partial credit. Supporting work should be neat and organized. A photo or scan of the supporting work should be submitted to the proper folder on Blackboard within 24 hours of exam completion.
- You will be required to prepare for and take each exam before the scheduled deadline. If you have a conflict with the deadline, an adjusted due date must be worked out with the instructor prior to the start of the exam.
