Homework

- Homework assignments will be due every Tuesday at midnight unless we are taking an exam. The homework will be completed on WebAssign.

- During each class period, you will complete a short worksheet covering the topics from the assigned lectures. If you are absent, you do not need to make up the worksheet.
- No late work is accepted. Due date extensions may be granted for extenuating circumstances.

Exams

- There will be 3 exams throughout the course and a cumulative final exam at the end. The exam dates are posted on the tentative weekly schedule.
- A formula sheet is provided for all exams.

Labs

- Labs will be completed each week unless we are taking an exam.
- Labs will be done in groups of 2-3 students. Your lab group will collect and analyze data together, but each person must turn in an individual lab report packet.
- Lab reports are due one week after the lab is completed, unless we are taking an exam.
- If you miss a lab, you must make it up another week. Occasionally, students are able to collect data for two labs in one evening. Otherwise, there will be an opportunity to complete make-up labs on Dec. 1 during class.
- One lab will be completed entirely on your own and require a typed, formal lab report. The instructions and grading rubric will be given after the 3rd exam. This lab will be graded as an exam.
