

## 2022-2023 Pell Lock-in Policy Effective Summer 2022

Pell awards will be recalculated twice in a semester, except for Summer 2022.

**For summer 2022**, the only Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 6/21/2022, since summer semester is one 8 week term.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

**For fall 2022**, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 9/13/2022. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 11/8/2022.

Students who increase their credits between 9/13 and 11/8 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 9/13 and 11/8 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly. Be Advised: Dropping a late start class after Pell has disbursed will result in a balance due for repayment of the Pell previously awarded.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.

**For spring 2023**, the first Pell award recalculation will be based on credits enrolled at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) on 2/7/2023. The second recalculation will be based on enrollment at 12:00 a.m. 4/11/2023.

Students who increase their credits between 2/7 and 4/11 will receive an increase in Pell accordingly.

Students who decrease the credits between 2/7 and 4/11 must incur the cost for the credits, and attend, or Pell will be decreased accordingly. Be Advised: Dropping a late start class after Pell has disbursed will result in a balance due for repayment of the Pell previously awarded.

An end-of-term review will be done to insure students attended and incurred the cost for the credits for which they receive Pell or Pell will be decreased accordingly.
