## **RESOLUTION FY 2013-15**

Tuition Fee Increase for FY 2013-2014

WHEREAS, H.B. 59 of the 130<sup>th</sup> General Assembly specifies that for the biennial budget effective July 1, 2013, "Each community college, state community college, and technical college shall not increase its in-state undergraduate instructional and general fees by more than \$100 over what the institution charged for the preceding academic year.", and

WHEREAS, Edison Community College is charging the following fees to all students in Fiscal Year 2013:

Instructional Fee	\$113.66/credit hour
General Fee	\$15.30/credit hour
Technology Fee	\$5.00/credit hour
Total	\$133.96/credit hour

Which calculates to \$4,018.80 in annual tuition per full-time equivalent student, or FTE, (i.e. 30 semester hours), and

WHEREAS, increasing student tuition by \$3.33/credit hour yields an increase of \$99.90 per annual, full-time equivalent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Edison Community College that the instructional fee be increased by \$3.33 to \$116.99 per credit hour, resulting in total tuition per credit hour of \$137.29 and therefore an annual tuition increase of \$99.90 per full-time-equivalent (30 credit hours) of enrollment.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that this increase become effective for terms starting on or after August 5, 2013.
