President's Report to the Edison State Community College Board of Trustees May 22, 2025

> President's Office

• The Advance Ohio Higher Education Act takes effect on June 27, 2025. The key requirements for higher ed institutions are as follows:

Governance & Compliance Support

- Trustee Training (R.C. 3333.045): ODHE to deliver annual training covering 17 key responsibilities. This training is required for all trustees, with a conference scheduled for September 18, 2025.
- Statement of Commitment (R.C. 3345.0216): Institutions must adopt and publish a 5-part commitment to free inquiry and intellectual diversity.

O DEI Restrictions (R.C. 3345.0217 - 3345.0218)

- Prohibits DEI offices, training, scholarships, and DEI-based hiring/promotion practices.
- Trustees must approve the policy within 90 days; failure to do so may result in the loss of state funds.
- Complaints must follow the Campus Free Speech policy (R.C. 3345.0215).
- Certain exceptions apply for legal compliance and research funding; the waiver process is in development.

Curriculum & Instruction

- Syllabi (R.C. 3345.029): Starting AY 2026–27, all undergraduate course syllabi must be posted publicly with specific requirements. Reporting is due July 31, 2026.
- American Civic Literacy Course (R.C. 3345.382): A mandatory 3-credit course for bachelor's degree students beginning with the 2029–30 graduates. Must be OT36-approved and board-approved.

Faculty Policies

- Workload (R.C. 3345.45): ODHE to define standards by Sept. 30, 2025. Institutions must adopt compliant policies by Dec. 31, 2025.
- Evaluation (R.C. 3345.451 & .452): Annual evaluations required, including bias-free classroom assessment. Policies must include appeals and be updated every 5 years.
- Post-Tenure Review (R.C. 3345.453): Mandatory for institutions with tenure; policies must include an appeals process and be submitted every 5 years.

o Program Elimination (R.C. 3345.454)

• Degree programs with fewer than five graduates per year over 3 years must be eliminated unless a waiver is granted. Applies only to institutions with tenure.

Reporting & Transparency

- Foreign Influence (R.C. 3345.591): Prohibits most gifts from China; mandates reporting of academic partnerships and foreign gift disclosures to ODHE.
- 5-Year Cost Summaries (R.C. 3345.80): Institutions must submit detailed cost reports for biennial state funding considerations, starting FY 2027–28.
- Equal Opportunity (R.C. 3345.88): Institutions must disaggregate and report data by race/sex on discipline, qualifications, and retention.

o Collective Bargaining (R.C. 3345.455–.456; R.C. 4117.14–.15)

• CBAs must comply with SB1 provisions. Faculty at two-year colleges are prohibited from striking.
