
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# COLLEGE CREDIT *Plus*


CCP is Ohio's dual enrollment opportunity for eligible students in grades 7-12.

## BENEFITS OF CCP

- ➊ Earn high school and college credits simultaneously
- ➋ Equip yourself for future college and career prospects
- ➌ Seamlessly transfer credits to other institutions
- ➍ Courses offered in accessible locations:
  - Edison State Campus
  - Online
  - Selected High Schools
- ➎ Courses may assist you in graduating from high school



# COST TO *Participate*



## PARTICIPATION IS *Free*

- ✓ No application fee
- ✓ No assessment fee
- ✓ Tuition and textbooks are included

### STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- ✓ Consumable supplies
- ✓ Financial risk for failed/withdrawn class

### PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS

- ✓ Participation is FREE within funding limits

### NON-PUBLIC AND HOMESCHOoled STUDENTS

- ✓ MUST apply for funding every year
- ✓ Amount of awarded credit hours may vary year to year

# COURSE Options

Eligible students can take up to 30 credit hours each academic year, including summer, fall, and spring semesters.

This figure is determined by the number of non-CCP courses completed in high school.

*30 - (secondary school units x 3) = CH for year*

## COURSE REGISTRATION LIMITS

- Prerequisites must be met before registering

## FIRST 15 RULE

- Completion of 15 credit hours at level I is required before advancing to level II.

## COURSE EXCLUSIONS

- Private lessons, remedial or developmental education, physical education programs, study abroad opportunities, high fees, and sectarian considerations.

## CCP PROBATION

- May only enroll in one College Credit Plus course for one college semester.
- May not enroll in a college course in the same subject in which the student previously earned a D, F, or received no credit.

# COURSE Content

CCP classes are college-level courses.

The topics covered will remain consistent, regardless of the location or the demographics of the enrolled students.

These classes may address mature subject matter that can be graphic, explicit, violent, or sexual in nature.

## MATURE CONTENT QUESTIONNAIRE

- Complete when submitting the CCP application.
- Verify necessary social and emotional maturity.
- Verify readiness to accept responsibility and independence necessary for the college classroom.

## PARENT/GUARDIAN PERMISSION

- Complete through the Edison State Admissions Portal.
- Must be signed by a parent or guardian.

## REVIEW

- Course descriptions
- Syllabi
- Required materials

# Grades

The grades earned in CCP courses are recorded on high school and college transcripts.

- ✓ 3, 4, 5 Credit Hours = 1 Carnegie Unit

## OPTION A VS OPTION B

- ✓ Option A—Self-pay for tuition and costs associated with a course. Choice of receiving both high school and college credits OR only college credit.
- ✓ Option B—Utilize state funds for tuition and costs associated with a course. This is the default option and the student will automatically receive both high school credit and college credit.

### OPTION A: SELF PAY

Be sure to notify us before the drop deadline if you do not want the grade to appear on your high school transcript.

### LASTING IMPACT

The permanent college record influences various factors, including high school and college GPAs, athletic eligibility, financial aid qualifications, and beyond.

**Probation & Dismissal:** State guidelines for students who are underperforming

**Financial Responsibility:** Reimbursement to high schools for associated costs

for CCP funding through the state by **APRIL 1st**  
for funding for the following school year.

# Apply

Admission into the College Credit Plus program must be completed before the start of the semester. Applications and supplemental items will not be accepted once the semester has started, regardless of course location.

## APPLICATION DEADLINES

- ✓ Summer 2026: June 8, 2026
- ✓ Fall 2026: August 24, 2026
- ✓ Spring 2027: January 18, 2027

- On the application, select the College Credit Plus option as your student type.

### SUBMIT SUPPLEMENTAL ITEMS

- Parent/Guardian Permission Slip
- High School Transcript (junior high students may submit a copy of their most recent report card)

NOTE: Your application is not complete until these items are uploaded.

### CHECK YOUR EMAIL

- Continue checking your email and admissions portal for important updates.

# Qualify

Edison State provides three pathways for determining eligibility for the College Credit Plus program.

## 01 3.0 GPA

- Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher

## 02 2.75 GPA + RELEVANT HS COURSEWORK

Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 2.75–2.99 with a grade of "A" or "B" in at least ONE of the following HS courses:

- English 10 or higher
- Geometry or higher
- Algebra II equivalent
- Any AP course
- Junior-level career technical course

## 03 COLLEGE READY ASSESSMENT SCORES

Students that meet college-ready assessment scores in at least ONE area

- Accuplacer: 250 Reading or 263 Math
- ACT: 18 English, 22 Reading, 22 Math

# Register

Registration occurs every semester.

For the best course selection and registration experience, it is highly recommended that prospective students complete the admission, assessment, and registration processes according to the timeline provided below.

## RECOMMENDED REGISTRATION TIMELINE

- ✓ Summer and Fall Registration—Complete before your high school's summer break.
- ✓ Spring Registration—Complete before your high school's winter break.

### 01 COURSES ON CAMPUS OR ONLINE

- CCP registration form
- All requests require counselor authorization
- Must be submitted before the start of the term

### 02 COURSES AT PARTNERING HIGH SCHOOLS

- Submitted to Edison State by your School Counselor

# COURSE *Placement*

The academic records submitted with your application will be evaluated to determine program eligibility and course placement.



# COURSE *Placement*

Typical prerequisite courses offered at Edison State include:

## 01 NO PREREQUISITES

Enrollment only requires program acceptance.

## 02 ENGLISH READY

Required for English Composition I and common for many general education courses

- ✓ 2.75 GPA + A or B in English 10 or higher
- ✓ Accuplacer: Reading Score 250+
- ✓ ACT: Reading Score 22+

03

## STATS/REASONING READY

Required for quantitative reasoning, statistics, and some science courses

- ✓ 2.75 GPA + Geometry or higher
- ✓ 2.75 GPA + Algebra II Equivalent
- ✓ Accuplacer: QRAS 263+
- ✓ ACT: Math 20+

04

## MATH READY

Required for college algebra, trigonometry, and precalculus

- ✓ 3.0 GPA + A or B in Algebra II or higher
- ✓ Accuplacer: AAF 263+
- ✓ ACT: Math 22+

# Course REGISTRATION

Once registration is complete, students receive information including:

- Student Guide
- Important Dates
- Textbook Information
- IT Help Desk

Students must follow Edison State's registration timelines for all schedule changes, regardless of course location.

## *Add*

Adding class before the start of the semester.

## *Drop*


Removing course before drop deadline with no penalty.

## *Withdraw*

Removing course after drop deadline. Students who elect to withdraw from a course will receive a W on their transcript and may be responsible for reimbursing their school district.
