

The Edison Foundation's 27th Annual Holiday Evening at Edison State Community College, was a vibrant, multi-stage holiday celebration. Guests were welcomed by the Charger Music Society, followed by simultaneous performances on three stages—featuring the Kim Kelly Orchestra, Parker Hastings, and the Springfield Symphony Orchestra String Quartet II—offering a mix of holiday classics and regional flair.
