The academic records submitted with your application will be evaluated to determine program and course eligibility. <u>Students who do not have a qualifying high school</u> <u>GPA should proceed to ACCUPLACER testing to establish eligibility.</u>

Program Eligibility & Course Eligibility... What's the Difference?

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY	COURSE ELIGIBILITY
Establishing program eligibility permits a student to participate in the CCP program. Program eligibility standards are set by the state. Program eligibility must be established before a student can determine what courses they are eligible to take. Establish CCP program eligibility one of three ways.	Meeting course eligibility requirements, or course prerequisites, permits a student to enroll in specific college courses. Course eligibility requirements are set by Edison State. Students who are program eligible AND meet the criteria listed below qualify for these common Edison State
 OPTION 1: 3.0 GPA Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of a 3.0 or higher. OPTION 2: 2.75 GPA & Relevant High School Coursework Students with a cumulative, unweighted high school GPA of 2.75 - 2.99 with a grade of "A" or "B" in at least ONE of the following high school courses: English 10 or higher Algebra II or higher Any AP course 	course prerequisites. NO PREREQUISITES: All students eligible for CCP qualify for courses without prerequisites. Examples: ART 123, BUS 110, COM 121, FIN 116 ENGLISH READY: Qualifying reading assessment score (ACT Reading 22+ or ACCUPLACER 250+) OR a 2.75 HS GPA and an A or B in English 10 or higher. Examples: ENG 121, HST 121, PSY 121, SOC 121
 Junior-level career technical course OPTION 3: College-Ready Assessment Scores Students that meet college-ready assessment scores in at least ONE area. ACCUPLACER: 250 Reading or 263 Math (QRAS or AAF portions) ACT: 18 English, 22 Reading, or 22 Math 	STATS READY: Qualifying math assessment score (ACT Math 20+ or ACCUPLACER QRAS 263+) OR a 2.75 HS GPA and an A or B in Algebra II or higher. Examples: BIO 121, MTH 120, MTH 125 MATH READY: Qualifying math assessment score (ACT Math 22+ or ACCUPLACER AAF 263+) OR a 2.75 HS GPA and an A or B in Algebra II or higher. Examples: MTH 122, MTH 123, MTH 128

Admission into the CCP program does not guarantee course eligibility. A full list of course descriptions and prerequisites can be viewed online through the academic catalog. Academic advising is available to assist students with eligibility information and course selection.
