

RESOLUTION FY 2012-10

Amendment to the Laboratory Fees Schedule – Fine Arts

WHEREAS, the current lab fee for this course has not been adjusted since 2003.

WHEREAS, printmaking supplies/materials are expensive—the cost of copper and zinc has increased dramatically, as well as the cost of buying ink and materials such as zinc/copper plates, linoleum blocks, and other miscellaneous items (specialized cleaning supplies, blankets for the press, etc.).

WHEREAS this proposed increase in lab fee will be to cover the cost of zinc/copper plates (\$11-\$25) and linoleum blocks (\$14-\$21). These two items cost per student ranges from \$25 to \$46 (depending on the size of the linoleum block and the materials chosen to use for etching—copper is more expensive than zinc). On the low end a lab fee of \$25 would cover most of the cost of these materials.

WHEREAS the funds for the ink, tool upkeep/replacement, and the other materials used (cleaning supplies etc.) will still come from the A&S supplies budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Edison Community College that the laboratory fee schedule be amended as follows, effective for the fall semester, 2012:
