

RESOLUTION FY 2013-15
Tuition Fee Increase for FY 2013-2014

WHEREAS, H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly specifies that for the biennial budget effective July 1, 2013, “Each community college, state community college, and technical college shall not increase its in-state undergraduate instructional and general fees by more than \$100 over what the institution charged for the preceding academic year.”, and

WHEREAS, Edison Community College is charging the following fees to all students in Fiscal Year 2013:

Instructional Fee	\$113.66/credit hour
General Fee	\$15.30/credit hour
Technology Fee	<u>\$5.00/credit hour</u>
Total	<u>\$133.96/credit hour</u>

Which calculates to \$4,018.80 in annual tuition per full-time equivalent student, or FTE, (i.e. 30 semester hours), and

WHEREAS, increasing student tuition by \$3.33/credit hour yields an increase of \$99.90 per annual, full-time equivalent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Edison Community College that the instructional fee be increased by \$3.33 to \$116.99 per credit hour, resulting in total tuition per credit hour of \$137.29 and therefore an annual tuition increase of \$99.90 per full-time-equivalent (30 credit hours) of enrollment.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that this increase become effective for terms starting on or after August 5, 2013.
