

RESOLUTION FY 2014-15

Tuition Fee Adjustment for FY 2013-2014

WHEREAS, H.B. 59 of the 130th General Assembly specifies that for the biennial budget effective July 1, 2013, “Each community college, state community college, and technical college shall not increase its in-state undergraduate instructional and general fees by more than \$100 over what the institution charged for the preceding academic year,” and

WHEREAS, Edison Community College is charging the following fees to all students in Fiscal Year 2014:

Instructional Fee	\$116.99/credit hour
General Fee	\$15.30/credit hour
Technology Fee	\$5.00/credit hour
Activity Fee	<u>\$1.00/credit hour</u>
Total	\$138.29/credit hour

Which calculates to \$4,148.70 in annual tuition per full-time equivalent student, or FTE, (i.e. 30 semester hours), and

WHEREAS, this exceeds allowable student tuition by \$1/credit hour or \$30 per full-time equivalent, and

WHEREAS, this \$1 overcharge also occurred in FY 2013, effective for terms starting on or after August 5, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Edison Community College that the general fee be decreased by \$1 to \$14.30 per credit hour, resulting in total tuition per credit hour of \$137.29, which equates to \$4,118.70 per full-time equivalent for terms starting after January 1, 2014.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that refunds of \$1 per credit hour be delivered to all students who were enrolled and overcharged at Edison Community College for terms starting on or after August 5, 2012 and before January 1, 2014.
