Creating an FSA ID

A step-by-step guide for creating a Federal Student Aid account, required to complete the FAFSA Form

Who is my parent for the FAFSA?

Name of the parent who provided the most financial support in the previous year:

Who needs an FSA ID?

All contributors will need an FSA ID. The FSA ID allows the contributor to give consent for the utilization of the federal tax information.

Contributor: any person who will be putting financial data on the FAFSA form. i.e. student, parent, step-parent, spouse, etc.

- 1. For dependent students: The contributor (parent) you will put on your FAFSA form is the one who provided the most financial support for you in the last year. If that parent is married at the time of FAFSA filing, you will also include their spouse on the form.
- 2. For Independent students: The contributor is yourself and your spouse if you are married at the time of completing your FAFSA form
- 3. 2022 tax filing status and current marital status: who needs an FSA ID?


**A marital status of "unmarried" can be a person who is single, widowed, or separated, but legally married
